Your prescription/order is shipped to you within 24 hours.

#### How do I refill my order?

Seven days before your bottle empties, call EBM Medical at 636-614-3152 Monday through Friday, 8AM-6PM CT. Do not stop applying DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> without talking to your healthcare professional.

#### What should I expect from DuraDerm<sup>™</sup>?

DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> is known to have activity against bacteria, fungi, and viruses that provides flexible covering over minor wounds and scrapes that are clean and dry. The film protects the wound against water, dirt, and germs and is not intended as a treatment or cure for all types of wounds. The elastic properties of the film help protect in difficult body regions where flexing, bending and creasing skin occurs. Upon application, mild stinging may occur.

#### How long does DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> take to work?

Depending on what condition your physician has prescribed DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> for, the length of treatment may vary. Minor cuts and scrapes generally heal within a few days. Your physician will instruct you on the usual length of therapy based on the condition being treated.

## How should DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> be removed before each application?

It is not absolutely necessary to remove DuraDerm<sup>TM</sup> completely from the area of application. DuraDerm<sup>TM</sup> is water resistant, but can be removed with soap and water. DuraDerm<sup>TM</sup> can also be gently peeled off.

#### How should DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> be applied?

Apply DuraDerm<sup>TM</sup> to a clean dry area using a disposable "Q-tip". Following application, please discard the "Q-tip" and ensure the cap is secured to prevent evaporation. The application is typically ordered for daily use but please use as directed by your prescribing healthcare provider.

#### The DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> bottle appears to be half full.

When received, your bottle will contain 20 mls. The bottle is oversized for ventilation purposes, so it is not uncommon to have it appear to be only half full.

#### What else is important to know about DuraDerm<sup>™</sup>?

DuraDerm<sup>™</sup> is intended for external skin use only and is not to be used on deep or infected wounds. Use with adequate ventilation. Intentional inhaling of the contents may be harmful or fatal. Keep away from children, do not use near eyes, mouth, or nose. Avoid contact of the solution with clothes or finished surfaces. Do not store near heat or flames. In case of ingestion, obtain medical assistance immediately.
